

Covid-19 test center at Vienna Airport

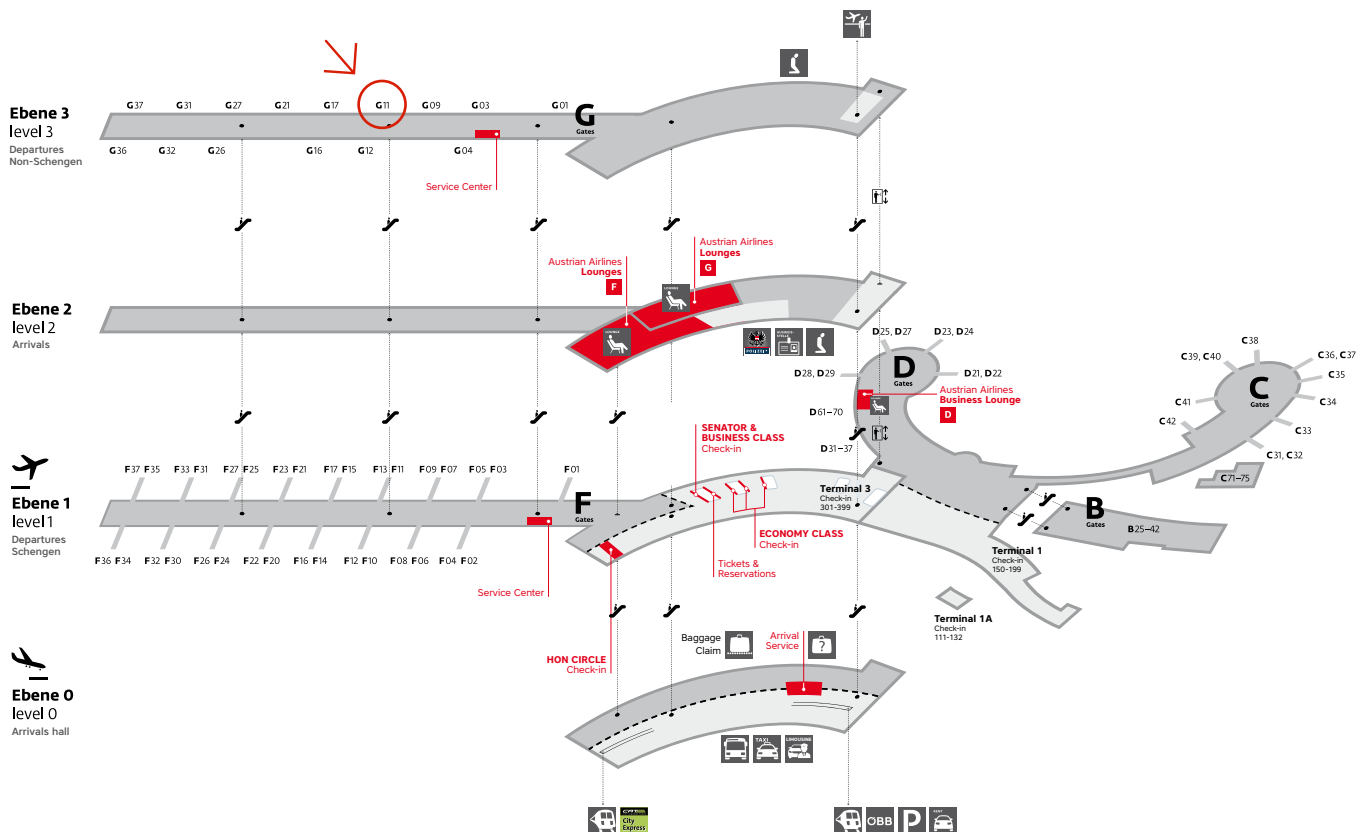
FOR FLIGHTS BOUND FOR CHINA MAINLAND

As of 18th December 2020, Austrian Airlines in cooperation with Flughafen Wien AG and Labor Dr. Mustafa offers a test center at Vienna Airport:

- the test center offers a PCR test and an IgM antibody test which are mandatory for flights bound for China Mainland
- the test center is located in the international transit area (Level 3 – G Gates | Service Center at Gate G11) to guarantee smooth travel – no Schengen visa needed
- the test center is available for transit passengers from 11:00 – 13:30.

Plan your Transfer

- Plan a layover of at least 8 hours at Vienna Airport to allow sufficient time to obtain the required Covid-19 test certificates and health codes from the Chinese Embassy in Austria.
- Test facilities are currently only available for Austrian passengers who hold 1 ticket for the whole journey bound for China Mainland on Austrian Airlines (OS075).
- As regulations are changing rapidly, please check with the Chinese authorities for the latest requirements and visit [Austrian Travel Regulations](#) for updates.
- Check [Covid-19 Test Requirements](#) for the exact procedure to obtain a Green HS Code (Chinese Citizens) or Green HDC Code (Non-Chinese Citizens) and a Red Customs Entry/Exit Health Code. For more information please refer to: <http://www.chinaembassy.at/det/xwdt/t1809604.htm>
- Passengers transferring from a domestic flight in Austria are asked to take the tests in their origin city within 48 hours before boarding their long-haul flight bound for China Mainland. Testing at the transit test center for passengers arriving from a domestic airport is not applicable.
- At Vienna Airport the required tests for the continuation of your travel to China Mainland are only offered at the transit test center at Gate G11. (Attention: Vienna Airport Health Center does not offer an IgM antibody blood test.)
- To use the transit test center please register online under <https://cshop.labor-mustafa.at>. This will allow us to simplify the process at the airport.
- The costs for both tests are EUR 160 per person. Payment is possible during online registration process or directly at the transit test center at Vienna Airport. You are welcome to pay cash (in EUR only) or by credit card (VISA, Mastercard, Diners)
- Before starting your first flight to Vienna please make sure to have the green HS or HDC code. Non-compliant passengers will not be accepted at the transit test center and may not continue their journey to China.

At Vienna Airport

- Please proceed to the transit test center at the earliest possible stage to take the tests. The transit test center is located at Level 3 – G Gates | Service Center at Gate G11
- The test center will conduct the PCR test and IgM antibody test in the same session.
- Guests who have not done an online registration before may do so directly at our transfer test center.
- **Please expect that the analysis will take at least 6 hours and that the test results will be available in the online portal from 19:00 at the earliest.** While waiting for the Covid-19 test results, scan the QR codes and begin registration for the Green HS Code (Chinese Citizens) or Green HDC Code (Non-Chinese Citizens).
- Upload the Covid-19 test results immediately upon receipt for verification by the Chinese Embassy in Austria. Once the Chinese Embassy has approved the application, your HS Code (Chinese Citizens) or HDC Code (Non-Chinese Citizens) will turn green.



- Upload the Covid-19 test certificates immediately upon receipt for verification by the Chinese Embassy in Austria. Once the Chinese Embassy has approved the application, your HS Code (Chinese Citizens) or HDC Code (Non-Chinese Citizens) will turn green.
